

#### NEGATIVITY BIAS

"People tend to focus more on the negative as they try to make sense of the world."

#### We tend to:

Pay more attention to negative events than positive ones



Learn more from negative outcomes and experiences.



Make decisions based on negative information more than positive data.



Historically, we are dealing with a new relationship between the state and dangers/threats/negative scenarios

#### The Premodern/Hobbesian State

Protection from Internal and External Violence.
The other threats were fought by the church.

The totalitarian/authoritarian state

Propaganda does not allow for "negativism" and self-doubt.

Defense against hybrid aggressions: propaganda and disinformation, cyber attacks, weaponisation of energy or food.

A New types of threats that are assumed in the security concept: biological threats, cyber threats, natural disasters, food crises, energy crises.

# CYBER

The perfect weapon

Hard to formally attribute.

It may initially target the private sector or local authorities (with insufficient cyber defense budgets).

#### Can target:

critical infrastructure

minds and souls

tools to deliver disruptive threats



## The Cyber Domain

the critical domain for building resilience in the next decade.

Cyber remains, statistically, the field with the greatest potential to spawn a black swan in the near future.
